# 16th Masters International Sprint Games 2025

Milwaukee, WI USA

Saturday, 22 February — Sunday, 23 February, 2025

This competition will be held according to the Constitution and Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) and the International Skating Union (ISU). The competition takes place indoors on the 400m standard track of the Pettit National Ice Center, on artificial ice. This competition is an event of the IMSSC 2024/2025 International Masters' Calendar.

### 1. Distances & Eligibility

The competition will take place on Saturday, 22 February and Sunday, 23 February, 2025. It is a four-distance sprint competition over a schedule of two days.

Day 1: Saturday, 22 February, 2025 Day 2: Sunday, 23 February, 2025

Women and Men: 500m #1 and 1,000m #1 Women and Men: 500m #2 and 1,000m #2

To be eligible, skaters must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license.

### 2. Age Groups

The competition takes place based on the following five-year age groups:

### 3. Schedule

### 3.1. Training Times Before Competition

All skaters may skate during speed skating pack sessions prior to the competition. The cost to skate during each speed skating pack session is \$19 USD.

Please see the timetable on the page 5 for information regarding the official training session. This official session will be free for all competitors.



### 3.2 Team Leaders Meeting

The team leaders meeting will be held on Friday, 21 February 2025, at 13:00, in the Hall of Fame room at the Pettit National Ice Center.

At this meeting, entries will be confirmed and information regarding the event will be distributed. The draw will take place immediately following this meeting. There will not be a second team leaders meeting.

Drawings at the Masters Sprint Games must be done according to ISU Rule 240 paragraph 4, with three exceptions:

- On all the distances all 5-year age will be drawn/paired together and will compete together (Women and Men separately).
- Pairing for the third and fourth distances will be done based respectively on the classification after 2 and 3 distances (independent of age group). In both cases the lane (inner and outer) will be changed for every skater with reference respectively to the first distance (for the third) and to the second distance (for the fourth). However, every classification and the final ranking after 4 distances, must be done in separate 5-year age groups.
- If at more than 100 participants are competing, they shall be divided into two or more blocks. The first block completes its two distances before the next block, and so on. This will reduce waiting time between the two distances.

A skater who completes all distances successfully and obtains the lowest total of points in his/her five-year age group wins the four-distance competition in that group.

### 4. Limit Times

If a skater wishes to participate in Masters Sprint Games, they must meet the following requirements in order to be allowed entry into the competition:

- 1. have a documented time (500m for MSG) on www.speedskatingresults.com, or similar, and;
- 2. have a documented time that meets the Minimum Time Standard (MTS) set forth in Rule 3.1.8, and;
- 3. have skated that MTS time during the previous two seasons.

If a skater fails to meet requirements 2) or 3) above they should contact their IMSSC Country Representative. The organizer of the Masters Sprint Games and the Board of the IMSSC will decide whether the request will be honored. ### 5. Limitation of Participants

No limitations or quota are foreseen by the organizing committee. For this event the OC is ready to host a maximum of 200 skaters. In the unlikely event that this number is exceeded, the OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants depending on the registration order.

Quartet starts may be used for the 1,000m distance.

### 6. Prizes

Any competitor who successfully completes the four-distance contest obtains a medal and a souvenir. For the four-distance combination, the first three competitors of each five-year age group will be awarded a prize. Any competitor who successfully finishes the competition without disqualification obtains a certificate containing the final results.

### 8. Entries

Entries must be made by filling in the Electronic Entry Form available on the PNIC website:

Dutch participants must first register via their regular channels on the website www.schaatscircuit.nl and inschrijven.schaatsen.nl in connection with their nomination/qualification process.

Confirmation of your participation can be ascertained in the Competitors' List present on the Sportity App.

A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person at the latest one hour before the first Team Leader Meeting of the competition. If the competitor is not able to confirm in person, he must inform the competition organization via email, phone, SMS or WhatsApp specifying first and last name at the latest 24 hours before the drawing of the competition.

Deadline for Entries: Friday, 31 January, 2025 at 23:00 CST



### 9. Entrance Fee

The entrance fee is fixed at \$150 USD per competitor. This includes a ticket to the Welcome Drink, a ticket to the Closing Banquet, as well as admittance to the official practice session on Friday 21 February from 9:00 to 11:15. The entrance fee must be paid prior to the registration deadline on 31 January, 2025 at 23:00 CST

### 10. Additional Tickets

For accompanying persons and coaches, tickets for the Welcome Drink (\$28 USD per person) and for the Closing Banquet (\$58 USD per person) may be bought from the OC. Please order these tickets on the entry form during registration. At the Closing Banquet, drinks are included.

No cost for spectators during the competition.

### 11. Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the ISU, the IMSSC and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for, or liability with respect to, bodily or personal injury, or property damages, incurred with connection with the Masters' International Sprint Games 2025. Each skater or accompanying person is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

### 12. Accommodation

The official Host Hotel for this event will be the Embassy Suites. Rooms are available for competitors to make arrangements for their stay. The Welcome Drink and Closing Banquet will take place at this location.
